Each week, students will learn about their faith and the importance of what it means to follow Jesus Christ. We want to help students understand that it is important to have faith and examine what it means to be obedient to God in following His plan for our lives.



KIDS DAY CAMP

Kids Day Camp is for students going in to Kindergarten through 2nd grades and is scheduled for June 28, 29, and 30. The camp is held from 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. The cost is \$40. Children are led through various stations throughout the camp including Bible teaching time, large group sports, and arts and crafts. Lunch and snacks are PROVIDED. Children need to bring swimwear.

ABOUT THE WEEKLY CAMPS

For Grades 3-12, registration on Sundays begins at 3:00 p.m. Campers may arrive and find out their cabin assignments, unload their belongings with the assistance of staff, meet their counselors, and families are encouraged to explore the camp together. Camp officially begins at 5:00 p.m. On Fridays, camp is dismissed at 9:00 a.m.

Intermediate Camp (July 9 - 14) is for students going in to 5^{th} and 6^{th} grades. The speaker this year is Rod Snow of Chalk for Christ. Rod is a chalk artist and ventriloguist.

Junior High Camp (July 16 - 21) is for students going in to 7^{th} and 8^{th} grades. The speaker this year is illusionist, Adrian Van Vactor. His mission is to use the art of illusion as a tool to bridge cultural and generational gaps and communicate the Gospel of Jesus Christ with the distinctive combination of apologetics and entertainment.

Senior High Camp (July 23 – 28) is for students going in to 9th through 12th grades. Those that have just graduated may also attend. The speaker this year is Lee Willis. Lee is the Discipleship Pastor at Cherry Hills Baptist Church in Springfield, Illinois.

Junior Camp (July 30 – August4) is for students going in to 3rd and 4th grades. The speaker this year is magician, Ken Shank with Dew Dah Magic. This year we are offering a new option for 3rd and 4th grade students based on feedback from previous years. Some students at this age are not ready to spend all week at camp so we would like to offer a day option. A student may be dropped off at camp at 8 a.m. and picked up at 8 p.m. and participate in camp throughout the day but have the opportunity to go home for the night.

COSTS

Complete the registration form on the next page and tear it off and return it to camp. The cost per camper for the four camps listed above is \$235.00. The new daytime participation for Junior Camp is \$150.00. All but \$30.00 is refundable if cancelled 7 days prior to the start of the designated camp. (The postmark will determine the date.) For those families who have multiple children coming to Spring Valley, we would like to offer a discount. If you register two campers at the cost of full registration, the third and each additional child will cost \$125. SAVE \$25.00! Register by June 1 with full payment and the cost is \$210.00. Early registration also helps the staff plan adequately for accommodations and counselors.
